





Plumbers' Putty or Caulking

1 INSTALL FAUCET WITH SPRAY

CAUTION Turn off water at main supply


INSTALL FAUCET

- Place FAUCET (1) in postion on sink or mounting surface.
- Assemble and tighten LOCKNUTS (2) from underside of sink or mounting surface. Hand tighten to secure FAUCET (1).

INSTALL SPRAY

- Place the HOLDER (4) into the appropriate mounting hole. Assemble the SPRAY HOLDER WING NUT (5) onto the shank of SPRAY HOLDER (4) from below and hand tighten.
- Feed SPRAY HOSE (6) through HOLDER (4) so SPRAY (3) sits in HOLDER (4).
- From underneath sink, attach COUPLING NUT (7) of SPRAY HOSE (6) to HOSE SHANK (8). Tighten COUPLING NUT (7) firmly.

SINK OR MOUNTING SURFACE




2 MAKE WATER SUPPLY AND WASTE CONNECTIONS

- Connect FLEXIBLE SUPPLIES (1, 2) directly to wall supplies.
 Connection on fitting supplies are 3/8" compression.
 Connect FLEXIBLE SUPPLY (1) (Marked with a Red Band) to the Left wall supply and FLEXIBLE SUPPLY (2) (Marked with a Blue Band) to Right wall supply.
- Connect the VALVE HOSES (3, 3a) to SPOUT TEE (4).
 Use adjustable wrench to tighten connections.
 Do not over tighten.
- Faucet supplies are 20" long from faucet base.

Note: If additional supply length is required, installer must purchase additional parts separately.


Important: If SUPPLY HOSES (1, 2) are to long, loop as illustrated to avoid kinking.

 Connect 1-1/4" O.D. tail piece on POP-UP DRAIN to waste outlet.




3 TEST INSTALLED FITTING

- With HANDLES (1) in OFF position, turn on WATER SUPPLIES (2) and check all connections for leaks.
- Remove AERATOR (3).
- Operate both HANDLES (1) to flush water lines thoroughly.
- Rotate SPOUT (5) in both directions.
- Replace AERATOR (3). Direct SPRAY (4) into sink and activate. Check hose connections for leaks.



4 SERVICE

- To change direction of handle rotation, proceed as follows:
 - Turn valve to OFF position.
 - Pull off HANDLE (1).
 - Pull off STEM ADAPTER (2).
 - Remove SPRING CLIP (4).
 - Lift STOP WASHER (3), turn 90° and replace.
 - Replace SPRING CLIP (4) and STEM ADAPTER (2).
 - Reinstall HANDLE (1).
- If spout drips, operate handles several times from OFF to ON position. Do not force - handles turn only 90°.



7 CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

DO: CLEAN WITH CLEAR WATER. DRY WITH A SOFT COTTON FLANNEL CLOTH.

DO NOT: DO NOT CLEAN THE PRODUCT WITH SOAPS, ACID, POLISH, ABRASIVES, HARSH CLEANERS, OR A CLOTH WITH A COARSE SURFACE.
